Dear Parents/Carers

Next week Hull Trinity House Academy is taking part in Good Morning Britain's Heels 4 Hearts campaign.

ITV's Good Morning Britain is running a week long campaign from 23rd - 28th March to encourage more people to learn CPR (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation) and in turn save lives. As part of the campaign, people are also being asked to donate shoes to help raise money for the British Heart foundation CPR training kits for every secondary school in Britain.

Currently fewer than 1 in 10 people in the UK know how to do CPR, and of those who do, many are not confident enough to carry it out. The aim is to get CPR training kits into every secondary school, so that every secondary school child will learn CPR and in turn teach their families too.

175 pairs of shoes equal a full training kit for a secondary school. But there are 3000 schools in the UK, so a lot of shoes are needed!

Please can you ask your son/charge to bring any unwanted shoes in to school during next week. They can be any shoes, adult or child, for men or women or even sports shoes. The only thing asked is that they are in good condition and suitable for resale.

Thank you for your support and tune into Good Morning Britain next week to see how the appeal is going.
