

# ART: KS4 Course Outline

	<p>In Art and Design students explore and investigate a range of processes, media and approaches to Art, looking at different artists and styles. Through research and investigations with different media students are able to understand the work of other artists and apply to their own practice.</p> <p>Over a term students will complete a course of study which will follow this pattern:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research page on chosen topic of study</li> <li>• Research page on the artist/style linked to the topic of study, looking at three different artists</li> <li>• Observational drawing using different techniques and use of media, these are expected to be completed weekly.</li> <li>• Experiments with different media, this must be wide range and can include digital, drawing, photography, painting ,collage, mixed media, 3D</li> <li>• Development of the chosen topic of study, this is where students will be able to become more independent, their final piece must reflect the artist’s work as well as show development of their own ideas</li> <li>• All of the students work will be annotated using an art vocabulary which will be extended throughout the year.</li> </ul> <p>It is expected that students complete 1 hour of homework a week which students often complete in the art room either on a lunch time or in after school club</p>
